Sites and Premises

Commercial property & land

Assistance can be given with the identification of available premises and land for business expansion or inward investment.

Development support

Employment & Skills

Apprenticeships

Apprenticeships are an excellent way to find eager employees who can be trained up to a high level in order to provide them with the skills needed to perform their job. North East Derbyshire District Council works with partners to promote and recruit apprenticeships within the district.

Graduates

The recruitment of graduates is a way to enhance the skills levels and performance of organisations by increasing management and leadership capability. Graduates can increase the intellectual capacity of the workforce, fill existing and/or future skills gaps, provide fresh and innovative perspectives and contribute technical expertise and knowledge.

Internships

An internship is a flexible period of work for a graduate, normally after graduating. There is no set time for an internship but it is recommended that it is a minimum of six months in order to get a reasonable return on the initial training that will be needed. An internship gives a business the opportunity to train and try potential future employees.

Workforce training

Business Relationship Managers can provide support in sourcing training and funding where available for workforce training and development.
